Westfall FFA Soil Judging Teams compete

Nine members of the Westfall FFA Chapter recently participated in the District 7 Soil Judging contest held in Knox County. Sarah Johnson, Austin Wippel, Devonah Kaiser and Clay Engle participated in the rural contest. Beau Adams, Beth Lane, Montana McFarland, Jesse Carle and Sierra Schleich competed in the urban contest. The rural team placed 10th and the urban team placed 7th.

Rural teams are required to evaluate a given soil judging pit site for agricultural purposes and determine slope, erosion, texture, depth, and drainage. They must also place the site in one of seven land judging classes, recommend the most intensive possible cropping practice, and make recommendations for conservation practices. The urban teams evaluate the sites for buildings, septic system leach beds, roads, and parks and recreational sites.
